- A. Text: Colossians 4:2-4.
- B. Prayer is to be a lifestyle.
- C. We are to pray that doors of opportunity might be open and that people might know how to share the gospel well.
- II. The place that God will prepare a person to share the Word is related to the preparation that a person puts forth ahead of time.
 - A. If God has called a person, He already has his place picked out.
 - B. We ought to pray for a place to share the Word, but God has already chosen that place.
- III. We need to pray for an opportunity to share the Word of God.
 - A. This is step number one.
 - B. We must ask if we want to make an impression or an impact.
 - C. Prayer is the greatest time saver in preparing the Word.
 - D. A sermon should be the expression of something that God has already done in one's life.
 - E. Prayerless preaching is powerless preaching.
 - F. We need to learn to depend upon God in order to be effective in our preaching.
 - G. One of the wisest things a person can do is to get people to pray for him.
 - H. Pride must be dealt with before preaching.
 - I. Faithful, fruitful, fearless, and fervency will describe the person's ministry, which is saturated in prayer.
