- I. Introduction. There are many extremes in dating.
- II. Types of dating.
 - A. Diversified dating through friendship.
 - B. Exclusive dating, this should precede engagement and marriage.
- III. Standards.
 - A. Standards of purity should be determined by God's rules.
 - B. One should never establish a dating relationship with a nonbeliever. For girls, missionary dating may make the girl the spiritual leader. (I Corinthians 6:14, Amos 3:3)
 - C. One should never date someone who is not growing.
 - D. Dating should not interfere with a person's walk with God or ministry.
 - E. Do not do anything that will interfere with one's walk with God: immorality (I Corinthians 6:13, II Timothy 2:22, I Thessalonians 4:3), defrauding (stirring up desires one cannot satisfy outside of marriage).
 - F. Trust God in this area.
 - 1. Be willing to be single if God so desires. Do not get hung up on being married. (Matthew 10:11-12, I Corinthians 7, I Timothy 6)
 - 2. Be willing to delay marriage for ministry training.
 - 3. Do not marry until you are convinced it is God's will for you. (Proverbs 19:14)
 - G. God will not withhold a good thing from someone who seeks Him. (Colossians 3:3, Proverbs 18:22, Psalm 84:11, 18:34, I Kings 18:56, Proverbs 19:55)
