I. Introduction.

- A. A large part of Crawford's life change came from people who invested in him through Scripture memory.
- B. Follow up is conserving the fruit of evangelism. (Proverbs 11:30)
- C. What glorifies God is a changed life. (Isaiah 61:3)
- II. Follow up is providing spiritual care for spiritual babes.
 - A. This is believer's responsibility. (Galatians 4:19, 1 Corinthians 4:15)
 - B. We follow up because it glorifies God. (1 Thessalonians 2:11-12)
 - 1. Parents are glorified when a child acts becomingly. (1 Corinthians 4:16)
 - 2. We are called to glorify God in our bodies. (1 Corinthians 6:19-20, Romans 6:13, Matthew 5:16, 3 John 4, 2 Corinthians 5:14)
 - C. An individual person is responsible for doing follow-up. (2 Corinthians 5:18-21, John 1:41, Philippians 1:6-7, 2:12)
 - D. What happens to converts is what we cause to happen to converts. (2 Peter 3:18, Ephesians 4:18)
 - 1. Sometimes one can be a Christian for a long time without having grown up spiritually. (Hebrews 5:12)
 - 2. You teach a young Christian by speaking to him. (1 Corinthians 3)
 - 3. A man is tremendously important because a convert does not sin in the light but the dark—the convert must be taught to put God's Word into practice.
 - 4. God wants a child following Him. (Ephesians 2:8-10, Titus 3:5)
 - E. Follow up by seeing the convert and seeing how they do. (Acts 15:36, Psalm 119:130)
 - 1. Get people into the Word of God.
 - 2. This will cause them to change.
 - 3. Get them to think about the Word, read it, study it, and memorize key verses in it. Use a Bible reading program to help.
 - 4. Start out by doing the work with them.
