- III. How to have a great ministry.
 - A. One must learn to present the gospel in the power of the Holy Spirit.
 - 1. A person can witness in an attractive way. (John 20:30-31)
 - 2. The power is not in a person, but in the gospel.
 - 3. The Holy Spirit must be the one to energize the presentation.
 - 4. A person can be filled with weakness, but still be filled with power. (I Corinthians 2:1-
 - 5, I Peter 1:23)
 - B. One must share the good news wherever one is at. One must set the pattern for godly, holy living. (James 4:14)
 - C. One must get others to imitate him. Other believers learned how to live by following Paul's example. (I Corinthians 11:1, 4:16, Philippians 4:9, 3:17, II Thessalonians 3:7-9)
 - D. One must teach others to reproduce.
