C. The holiness of God is emphasized uniquely among God's attributes. It describes his separateness and perfect character. (Isaiah 6; Revelation 4; 1 John 1:5)
II. God is to be our standard. (Ephesians 4:24)
III. We are to be holy in all that we do.
IV. Implications.
A. We must take all sin seriously.
1. Sin is rebellion against God. (Leviticus 16:21)
2. Sin is a despising of the person and Word of God. (2 Samuel 12:9-10)
3. Sin is a defiance of the Word of God. (1 Kings 13:21)
B. God has laid our iniquity on Jesus Christ.
C. Only by the power of the Spirit will we make progress in holiness.
