- V. Cause and effect seven laws of the harvest.
 - A. We reap only what is sewn.
 - 1. The problems like race are there, but they do not have to be there for us in Christ. (Psalm 9:17)
 - 2. The answer is in turning to God in prayer. (2 Chronicles 7:14)
 - 3. We only reap what has been sewn.
 - B. We reap the same in kind as we sew. (Psalm 23, Job 4:8)
 - 1. King David was guilty of murder and adultery.
 - 2. Several of David's sons and concubines were murdered.
 - 3. Jacob and Joseph's brothers both reaped what they sew.
 - C. We reap in a different season than we sew.
 - 1. God is on our side.
 - 2. We are to wait upon the Lord. (Psalm 27:14, Isaiah 40:31, Habakkuk 2:3)
 - D. We reap more than we sew. (Romans 5:12)
 - E. We reap in the same proportion as we sew. (2 Corinthians 9:6-7)
 - F. We reap the full harvest of the good only if we persevere; however, evil comes on its own.
 - 1. In our life nothing stands still.
