III. A new and living way through Jesus. (John 14:6)

A. There is no way that man can be in fellowship with God than by the death of Jesus.

- B. There is salvation in no one else besides Jesus. (Acts 4:12; Hebrews 10:19; John 14:18)
- IV. A transforming intimacy between God and man.

A. Jesus became friends with the most ordinary men. (Acts 4:13)

B. When we spend time with Jesus, people will know it. (Colossians 1:21-22)

C. An invitation to intimacy with God provides mankind a second chance.(Colossians 1:27; 2 Corinthians 5:17)

V. The internal leadership and power of the Holy Spirit.

A. The ministry of the Holy Spirit is to point to Jesus. (John 14:16; Acts 1:8; Colossians 2:9-10; 2:2-3)

B. It is all in Jesus. (Romans 8:9)

C. To be filled with the Spirit means to be controlled by the Spirit.

D. Jesus has made us kings and priests. (Revelation 1:5-6; 1 Peter 2:9)

E. The Holy Spirit ended spiritual hierarchy and placed the privileges of spiritual service to all believers.

VI. Sending into the world as ambassadors. Jesus has sent us in the world to share the message of salvation. (Luke 19:10; John 20:21; 17:18)
