- A. The only answer to the problems we face today is Jesus Christ.
- B. Our culture is rejecting Christianity and the church is borrowing secular philosophies. Many people reject moral absolutes.
- II. God will take care of us if we seek first the kingdom of God. (Matthew 6:24, 33)
 - A. The kingdom of God is wherever God is king.
 - B. Everybody serves someone or something.
 - C. The kingdom of God must be sought first, which has implications for right living.
- III. If we are going to seek God's kingdom, we have to figure out God's objective.
 - A. God's objective is to get people saved. (1 Timothy 2:4; 2 Peter 3:9)
 - B. Jesus came to save sinners. (Luke 19:10; 1 Timothy 1:15)
 - C. The Spirit came to convict the world and give power for witness. (John 14; Acts 1:8)
 - D. If God's will for us is to become more like Jesus, we are to be witnesses to a lost and dying world. (Romans 8:29; Ephesians 4:11; John 12:32; 20:21; 17:18)
