 - 1. Sin is not funny—it cost Jesus His life and is costing others their lives. (I Peter 1:15-16)
 - 2. The basis of acceptance is the blood of Christ, but one disciplines himself for godliness. Godliness is the motivation. (Matthew 28)
 - 3. It is important to memorize verses and study because you are building a foundation for the rest of your life.
 - 4. One must make sure he or she knows where his or her future spouse is going before making a commitment to marriage.
