I. Introduction.

- A. The most effective means of evangelism today is visitation evangelism on the part of spiritually trained laity.
- B. Personal testimony.

II. The problem.

- A. While we are getting many people in the church too many are leaving.
- B. Too few are also doing the work. Every child of God is to be a servant and a missionary.

III. The solution.

- A. The end product of evangelism is a Christian who has then become a witness.
 - 1. The objective is to present every man perfect in Christ Jesus. (Colossians 1:28)
 - 2. This means first sharing the gospel with all people.
 - 3. This means secondly to teach every man with all wisdom. (John 15, Proverbs 11:30)
- B. Every person who comes to Christ has the potential for reproduction.
 - 1. It is our responsibility to care for new Christians. Something has to be done.
 - 2. Follow up is best done not by something but by someone. Follow up is not effective without personal help. (Jeremiah 3:15)
 - 3. Every Christian is going to have to help. Leaders exist to equip others to edify the body. (Ephesians 4:11-12)
- C. How reproduction can be done (according to the Apostle Paul).
 - 1. Prayer. This determines our heart for new converts. (Ephesians 3:14-21)
 - 2. Through follow up. This includes tips on fighting Satan, Scripture memory, and sending the name to a person who can actually meet the person.
 - 3. By sending others. Satisfaction comes from seeing a person led to Christ lead another. You help others so they can help others. (Deuteronomy 8:1)
