 - B. In Nehemiah the problems were solved by returning to the work that is, the wall.
 - 1. Nehemiah had to tend to organizational things, but he always returned back to the primary work.
 - 2. Organizational leaders need to return back to discipleship.
 - C. Supported objectives have to be done but not at the expense of corporate objectives. (Acts 6)
 - 1. The Apostles' answer was prayer, the Word and men.
 - 2. When the work is finished, we are to return to prayer, the Word and men. These are our priorities.
 - 3. We ought to re-evaluate what we do in the ministry because of these priorities.
 - 4. Everybody is expected to be in prayer, discipleship and evangelism.
 - D. All minor objectives need to be measured by the minor objectives.
 - E. Conclusion: Have any free time? Get back to the basics.
