C. Scripture (2 Timothy 3:16)
1. Is the source of knowledge about God's will.
2. Reproves us.
3. Corrects us.
4. Trains us in righteousness. (Ephesians 6:4; Hebrews 12:5ff; Ephesians 4:28)
D. Holiness is to permeate every area of our lives including our attitude. (Philippians 2:3-4)
III. Reinforce convictions by commitment.
A. Make a general commitment to be holy. (Romans 12:1-2)
B. Make specific commitments about sin issues. (Daniel 1:8; Job 31:1)
