Beware of the Booby Traps Howard Hendricks

Introduction.

- A. I want to speak on the subject of booby traps.
- B. We need to identify the traps in the spiritual realm.
- C. In golf I have learned to stay on the fairway because off the fairway is trouble.
- I. Paul reminds us that we are not in the dark with respect to demonic strategies. (2 Corinthians 2:11)
 - A. The devil is like a roaring lion seeking someone to devour and his favorite food is effective Christians, not the ineffective ones.
 - B. I want to recommend a study of the term "leaven," which is always used in an evil sense, in four ways.
 - 1. The leaven of the Pharisees, which is hypocrisy. (Matthew 16:11-12)
 - a. The disciples thought Jesus meant the bread of the Pharisees.
 - b. Jesus meant the teaching, however, as hypocrisy is the following:
 - 1) Ritual without reality.
 - 2) Motion without meaning.
 - 3) Rule with out relationship
 - 4) Performance without character
 - 5) It is counterfeit of the real thing.
 - i. Counterfeiters spend little time with false bills but much time with genuine bills.
 - ii. We nee to spend much time with the true teaching of Jesus in order to identify the counterfeit.
 - c. Jesus hates hypocrites, people trying to pull off a profession.
 - d. Hypocrisy means to speak from under a mask.
 - 1) It is a theatrical term.

- 2) It cam to mean a phony, like the Pharisees, who Jesus faulted not for their doctrine but for their failure to do the right thing. (Matthew 23:3)
- 3) The goal from true instruction is love from a good conscience and a sincere faith. (1 Timothy 1:5)
 - i. Sincere means without wax, as in a vase that is without cracks patched up by wax.
 - ii. A sincere person is without wax, but not necessarily without cracks.
- e. There is a cause effect relationship between an impure heart and a guilty conscience, which produces a phony lifestyle.
 - 1) We nee to be open to self-disclosure.
 - 2) We don't need more guilt but true disconnections with the truth of God's word.
 - 3) It's not other's expectations that count but God's expectations.
 - 4) Revelation teaches reality that we need to respond to.
 - i. Correct it.
 - ii. Fake it.
 - iii. Chunk it. Hundreds of people bail out of Christianity, rejecting phony Christians.
- 2. The leaven of the Sadducees is humanism, eliminating the supernatural.
 - a. These denied the resurrection and angels.
 - b. They believed the universe is s closed system.
 - c. This is the philosophical system of today.
 - d. Deity and revelation will not save us, starting with Nietzsche.
 - e. But the key teaching of humanism is that man is to glorify man and live as long as he can.
 - 1) Many Christians live by this philosophy.
 - 2) Jesus says if you want to live give your life away.
 - 3) Philosophical humanism is invading the church today.

- f. Humanism limits human accomplishments to human ability.
 - 1) How would the Navigators be like if not for the supernatural?
 - 2) The same or drastically different?
 - 3) Are we doing only what a human organization can do, or we doing what no human organization can do?
 - 4) Are we convinced that God is sovereign or do we believe God is biting his nails?
 - 5) Is the supernatural possible or are we just grinding it out?
 - 6) The Jews balked at possessing the land. (Numbers 13)
 - 7) Are we convinced we can take the land with God's help?
 - 8) Only Joshua and Caleb entered the land because they believed in God's power.
 - 9) Their secret is that they saw more than the giants and the grasshoppers; they saw God.
 - 10) Remember we are serving God.
- g. The deceptive thing about humanism is its reasonableness, but the dramatic thing of Christianity is its radical ness.
 - 1) The righteous ones live by faith and if they shrink back God has no pleasure in them. (Hebrews 10:38)
 - i. To shrink back means to take down your sail.
 - ii. This one does not please God.
 - 2) The supernatural power of God wants to use your sail.
- 3. The leaven of the Pharisees of immorality is deeply rooted in evangelisms.
 - 1. A little leaven leavens the lump of God, which is impurity. (1 Corinthians 5:6-7
 - 2. Right now we have evangelical leaders living in sin.
 - 3. God wants to place a clean person in a corrupt society.
 - 4. Are we making an impact on society or is society making an impact on us?

- 5. DaVinci said that if a cube of lead is placed on gold the two will intermingle, and the lead will debase the gold and not the other way around.
- 6. Computer industry tells us "Garbage in, garbage out."
- 7. Jesus said that looking with lust is sin.
- 8. What we read will determine what we think.
- 9. Do you have the spiritual guts to walk out on a film that poisons your mind?
- 10. A seminary student got involved in pornography and it destroyed him.
- 11. No cleaver arrangement of rotten eggs will make a good omelet. (1 Thessalonians 4:3-5)
- 12. We are not to be complicated by sin, though we embrace sinners.
- 4. The leaven of legalism.
 - a. Christ set us free and we are to remain in that freedom. (Galatians 5:1)
 - b. Are you free today or are you in bondage?
 - c. I was raised in a culture that said a woman with red fingernail polish could not lead a person to Christ.
 - d. Faith works through love, regardless of what kind of fingernail polish they use.
 - e. I was trying to love Christianity by man made rules.
 - f. Nothing we do will make God love us more or less.
 - g. We don't need to live according to other's expectations.
 - h. We don't do whatever we want, but whatever God wants.
 - i. Love does not work by rules but by relationship.
 - j. Legalists build walls; lovers build bridges.
 - k. God will discipline us but he does it in love. (Titus 2)
 - 1. I am jealous of the Navigators because their objective is close to the heart of the Savior. This is why I am also concerned for you because Satan opposes you.

- 1) The leaven of the Pharisees will wipe you out if you are not careful.
- 2) Many have already fallen.
- 3) A friend is serving God in Canada doing a marvelous work for God and he was recently interviewed by a Satanist who told him they are praying to Satan for the destruction of evangelicals.
- 4) Serving God is not a fun and games operation.
- 5) We need to stand strong in the faith and face the battle.
- C. God protect us from the leaven of the Pharisees and Sadducees.
 - 1. The leaven of hypocrisy.
 - 2. The leaven of humanism.
 - 3. The leaven of immorality.
 - 4. The leaven of legalism.
