I. Introduction.

- A. We are to love one another. (1 Timothy 1:5, 1 John 4:11-12)
 - 1. Because God is love. We are partakers of the divine nature and cannot help but love because God is love.
 - 2. Because God sent His Son.
 - 3. Because if we love one another, God's love is perfected in us.
- B. We are to love out of a good conscience towards God and man. (Acts 24:16)
- C. We are to have a sincere and genuine faith.

II. A sincere faith.

- A. Faith is important because it receives grace. (Hebrews 11:6, Romans 1:17)
- B. We are not to follow in manner or method but imitate in faith.
- C. What is faith?
 - 1. It is an inner assurance that counts on God and obeys Him.
 - 2. It rests on the objective fact of God and His character—primarily that He is reliable.
 - 3. It also rests on the subjective experience of obeying God. (John 7:17)
 - 4. One obeys his way to faith.
 - 5. Faith is both passive and active. It rests on God's character and it also obeys Him. (Romans 1:5, Hebrews 11)
- D. Faith must be tested. (1 Peter 1:11)
 - 1. Sincere faith is very important to God.
 - 2. Sincere faith is important to us because it produces steadfastness—stable, consistent character.
 - 3. The ultimate cause of all spiritual depression is unbelief.
 - 4. Abraham's faith grew by the very act of trusting and obeying Him.
 - 5. The greatest test of faith is to trust God for people. (Psalm 37:3)

	E. Faith is a lifetime thing.
	F. Faith is a painful thing.
	1. Faith stays us when all other things are stripped away—we come down to God Himself.
	2. Yet faith in God is a blessed experience and is worth it all.
	G. Faith develops us into mature people. (Hebrews 12:27)
	H. As with Abraham faith will bring us honor from the Father.
