- I. The calling of the ministry has to do with multiplying laborers through the world. Laborers are "fruitful branches." (John 15:7)
- II. The fruitful branch.
 - A. God wants each disciple to be a fruitful branch.
 - B. We have two needs that must be satisfied.
 - 1. Security—to be loved.
 - 2. Significance—a sense of doing something important that will last for eternity.
 - 3. Both of these are found in being a fruitful branch.
- III. What it means to be a fruitful branch.
 - A. Abiding in Christ.
 - 1. Abiding means to be connected to Christ.
 - 2. Without contact with Christ, the spiritual life dies.
 - 3. Christ is the power, and we are the transmitters.
 - 4. One abides in Christ through surrender. It is both an initial and continual activity.
 - 5. If one is not certain whether he has received Christ for the forgiveness of sins, he can do it for the first time immediately by asking Him into his heart.
 - B. Having Christ's Word abide in the disciple.
 - 1. The branch needs to be pruned.
 - 2. Three reasons we need to be pruned.
 - a. For health.
 - b. For shape.
 - c. To produce more and better flowers from fruit. God prunes us to reward us.
