I. Introduction.

- A. We have a special treasure in the Scriptures because they can make us wise for salvation. (II Timothy 3:15)
- B. The Scriptures introduces us to Christ. (Acts 4:12)
- C. The primary way the Spirit speaks is through the Word.
- II. The mind needs to be renewed through the Word of God. (Romans 12:1-2)
- III. God warns us through the Scriptures about mistakes we make. (Joshua 9:14, Matthew 22:29, Psalm 119:133, 9-11, 19:11)
- IV. Objections to memorizing Scripture.
 - A. It is too difficult to memorize.
 - 1. However, people memorize things all the time. It is a matter of work and not of memory. (e.g., I Corinthians 10:31)
 - 2. A person does not memorize because it is not meaningful to them.
 - B. It takes Scripture out of context.
 - 1. This does not have to be the case.
 - 2. Scripture memory can help a person understand context.
 - 3. Memorizing Scripture helps for witnessing since one does not always have a Bible with him.
 - C. A person does not have time.
 - 1. People waste a lot of time, so it is difficult to believe that people do not have time.
 - 2. People have the time they just must make it.
 - 3. One verse a week makes fifty-two a year.
 - 4. One must be prepared for an answer. (I Peter 2:15, Jeremiah 20:9, Luke 24:32)
- V. Reasons to witness.
 - A. It will help one to witness.

B. It will help one to grow. (Acts 20:32, I Peter 2:3)

C. It will help one to counsel others. (Proverbs 22:21)

D. It will help one to control one's communication. (Ephesians 4:29, Psalm 12:6)

E. It will give guidance. (Psalm 119:105, 130)
