VI. The Discipline Of Memorizing God's Word Proverbs 7:1-3

A. Successful Scripture Memory Simplified.

1. Print your own verse on a card and learn it by repeating phrases in the verse until you can quote it word perfectly.

2. Then review that verse out loud every day for two months using only the reference to prompt yourself.

3. Put the verse card into a card file system, called a "Back Review" so you review them once a week. Review them for the rest of your life.
