  - E. The Bible teaches that we will continue to sin and have provision for forgiveness—God's word will convict us and call us to make things right with God and man. (1 John 1:9)

- IV. We grow through the Word. (2 Peter 3:18, 1 Peter 2:2)
  - A. This growth starts from the thoughts. (Proverbs 23:7, Mark 7:21-23)
  - B. We are supposed to live from the fruit of the thoughts. (Matthew 12:34)
  - C. Thoughts reflect the soul. (2 Peter 2:8)
  - D. The Word helps us to sustain against the flesh. (1 Peter 2:11, Matthew 7:24)

- E. We seek to teach and represent Christ.
- F. Our thought content changes by our intake of the Word of God. (Matthew 22:29, 1 John 2:14, Psalm 119:111)
- G. We can actually tell whether we are growing. (1 Corinthians 3:1-5, 2 Corinthians 4:16)
- V. We disciple through the Word.
  - A. You can spend your life raising up disciples who will fill all the fields of ministry that you want to fill.
  - B. We are to sew the Word. (Mark 4:14, 1 Peter 4:11, 2 Corinthians 5:19-20)
