 - 1. Only 3 verses in NT on tithing. (Matthew 23:23, Luke 18:12, Hebrews 7:5)
 - 2. There were three tithes in the Old Testament.
 - a) They gave a tithe at the feast. (Exodus 23:16, 19)
 - b) They gave a tithe to the poor. (Deuteronomy 26:12, 14:28)
 - c) They gave a tithe to the Levites. (Numbers 18:21)
 - 3. The New Testament does not give specific instructions.
 - a) The law was a schoolmaster to bring us to Christ. (Galatians 3:24)
 - b) The Lord deals with us as adults now.
 - 4. It all belongs to God.
 - 5. The decision is between you and the Lord. (2 Corinthians 9:6-7)
 - 6. The issue is not as much the amount you give, but how you manage the rest. (Romans 14:23)
 - a) If you can't spend your money to the glory of God, then don't do it.
