 - C. This is not a judgment of condemnation but of reward. (1 Corinthians 3:12-13)
 - D. Bema is the seat that one comes to receive rewards.
- III. The judgment of the Jews.
 - A. This takes place at the tribulation. (Ezekiel 20:34-38)
 - B. This takes place because the Jews rejected Jesus as a nation. (Daniel 12:1; 1 Samuel 8:7; Luke
 - 23:18; Acts 7:51)
- IV. The judgment of the nations.
 - A. This happens at the beginning of the Millennium.
 - B. Their judgment will be based on their treatment of the Jews. (Matthew 25)
- V. The judgment of the wicked dead and angels. (Revelation 20:11-15)
- VI. The Great White throne judgment.
- VII. The order of future events.
 - A. The Rapture of the saved. (1 Thessalonians 4:15-16; Matthew 24:40-42; Luke 17:34-36)
 - B. The Jews will be re-gathered in Jerusalem. (Ezekiel 36:20-24)
 - C. The Tribulation.
 - D. The world will be divided into different power structures. (Ezekiel 33:39; Daniel 11:40-45;
 - Job 22:20; Daniel 7:1-20; Revelation 15:1-3; 16:12-16)
 - E. The antichrist will arise to take control of the ten world confederacy.
 - F. The one world church will arise. (Revelation 17; Isaiah 47)

G. The antichrist will set up in Jerusalem and demand the mark of the beast.
H. The seven seals, trumpets and bowls are all judgments that will occur.
I. The armies set up and Jesus returns to destroy them all. (Revelation 19)
J. The Millennial Kingdom is set up, Christ rules on earth and Satan is bound. (Revelation 20)
K. Satan is released, God appears for the final White Throne Judgment. (Revelation 21; 1 Peter
3:10)
VIII. The signs of the time. (1 Chronicles 12:22; Matthew 16:2-3)
A. The beginning of the last days started at Pentecost. (Job 2:28-29; Acts 2:17-28)
B. The signs of the end times that will come. (Matthew 24)
