I. Introduction.

- A. The gifts of the Holy Spirit appear in 1 Corinthians 12, Romans 12 and Ephesians 4.
- B. Tongues and healing are the controversial gifts of today.
- II. God decides who will get what spiritual gift. (1 Corinthians 12:11)
- III. Gifts are given for our edification and the edification of the church. (1 Corinthian 12:7)
- IV. The gifts are to be used in the body. (1 Corinthians 12:18)

V. Healing.

- A. We have sickness because of sin. (Ecclesiastes 7:25)
- B. Types of healing.
 - 1. One Christian praying for another. (James 5:16)
 - 2. Anointing by and prayer of the elders. (James 5:14-15)
 - 3. The special gift of healing. The gift is plural because each gift is a special gift in itself. (1 Corinthians 12:9)
 - 4. Medical doctors.
- C. We need to come to physical healings with balance. (John 17:4; Galatians 6:7)

VI. Tongues.

- A. There is a genuine gift of tongues—Scripture has not said they are ceased.
- B. Tongues can be counterfeit.
- C. We must be careful where we get the gift from.
- D. Some get tongues from hyper-emotionalism.
- E. The biblical practice of tongues should be by two or three in a given meeting and only if an interpreter is present. (1 Corinthians 14:27-28)
- F. Women are to remain silent.
- G. The value of tongues is self-edification. (1 Corinthians 14:4, 14)
- H. Paul spoke in tongues more than everyone. (1 Corinthians 14:9, 18)

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- A. Tongues are not a sign of spirituality. The real mark of spirituality is the fruit of the Spirit. (1 Corinthians 1:7; 3:1-3; Galatians 5:22-23)
- B. Sometimes sign gifts come from the wrong source.
- C. Sometimes the sign gifts divide the body of Christ. (1 Corinthians 12:25)
- D. Sometimes the sign gifts are taken as signs of the fullness of the Holy Spirit.
- E. Sometimes people who have the sign gifts emphasize the experience more than anything. The Spirit's work is to glorify Jesus. (John 15:14, 26; Acts 1:8)
- F. Some over-emphasize the sign gifts.
- G. Some take their experience as a greater authority than the Bible. (2 Timothy 3:16; 2 Peter 1:21; Proverbs 30:5; Luke 21:33; Hebrews 1:1-2; Luke 24:27)
